

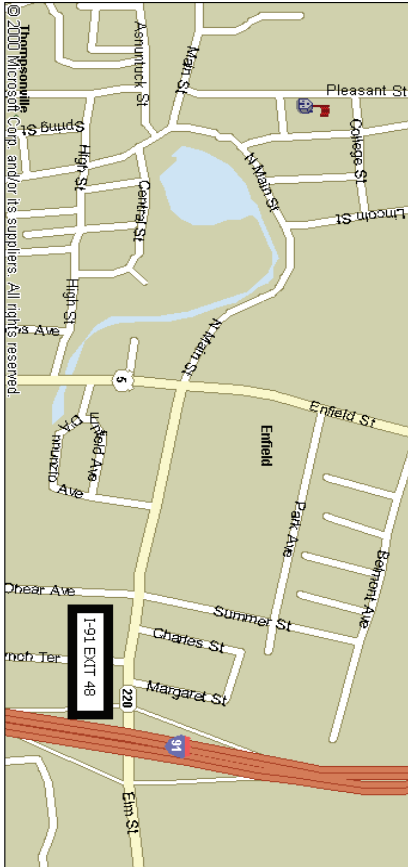
### Directions

#### FROM SPRINGFIELD AND POINTS NORTH:

11 Miles South of Springfield MA  
Take Rt. I-91 (South)  
Take I-91 Exit 48, at end of Ramp Turn RIGHT  
Onto [Elm St] (West) through 1 light and continue on  
(N) Main St- 0.8 mi  
At end of pond Turn RIGHT onto Main St.- 0.1 mi  
Immediately Turn RIGHT onto Pleasant St.- 0.2 mi  
Arrive 36 Pleasant St, Enfield, CT on RIGHT

#### FROM HARTFORD AND POINTS SOUTH:

20 Miles North of Hartford CT  
Take Rt. I-91 (North)  
At I-91 Exit 48, at end of Ramp Turn LEFT  
Onto [Elm St] (West) through 1 light and continue on  
(N) Main St- 0.8 mi  
At end of pond Turn RIGHT onto Main St.- 0.1 mi  
Immediately Turn RIGHT onto Pleasant St.- 0.2 mi  
Arrive 36 Pleasant St, Enfield, CT on RIGHT

## **To be eligible for admission to Enfield Recovery House an individual must:**

- Be 18 years or older
- Be able to live independently with minimal supervision
- Be in need of transitional housing
- Be willing to abide by all the policies and regulations of Enfield Recovery House

## **Individuals who will not be accepted for admission are those:**

- Needing emergency psychiatric care
- Requiring detoxification
- With a history of serious violence
- With needs that cannot be met by existing program
